Please read carefully and follow instructions.

Essays that do not comply with the guidelines will be disqualified.

GUIDELINES

1. Your essay should be based on library reference sources and web-based research and should include a summary of current scientific research relevant to your topic. You must cite your research sources and include a bibliography. Be sure to include at least one book or scientific journal as reference in your bibliography. **The essay should be written in the student's own words and no portion should be copied verbatim.**
2. **The essay should focus on research** and should discuss the biomedical aspect of the issue, not the ethical or social issues.
3. Your essay should be well written with **proper grammar, spelling, and punctuation**.
4. Your essay must be written expressly for The Wistar Institute's 2008 Biology Essay Contest.
5. Original illustrations to accompany your essay are encouraged but not required.
6. Your essay should be two to four typed, double-spaced pages.
7. Use 8-1/2 x 11-inch paper with a 1-inch margin on all sides.
8. Your essay submission must be an original. Photocopies or duplicates will not be accepted.
9. A completed entry form must be stapled to the upper left-hand corner of your essay. The entry form must be signed by a science teacher who has reviewed the essay. Your name, school and grade should appear **only** on the entry form. To facilitate the judging process, **please do not print your name on the essay**.
